Risk management has assumed great importance in recent times in view of the deficiencies in risk management practices followed by banks, especially the PSBs; and this has led to a sharp deterioration in their asset quality. PSBs have assumed huge exposure to certain sectors, especially infrastructure sector, and due to a combination of adverse internal and external factors this has exposed them to higher level of stress. The recent decision by the Government to link capital infusion in PSBs to performance has also added some pressure on them as far as capital planning and maintenance is concerned.
